

Guidelines for temporary structures at luge tracks

1. Fundamental rules

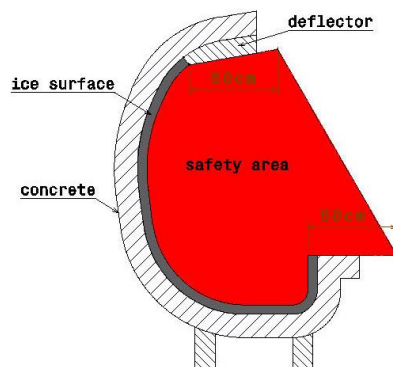
- a) These guidelines are valid for all FIL competitions and all FIL training events and apply to all companies and other institutions that erect installations or structures on or near the track body before or during this event. This also applies to TV broadcasters, advertising companies and sponsors as well as craft businesses for stage building etc.
- b) These guidelines are valid for all people who install temporary structures and installations, use these structures and devices during FIL competitions and FIL training events.

2. Inspections and conditions

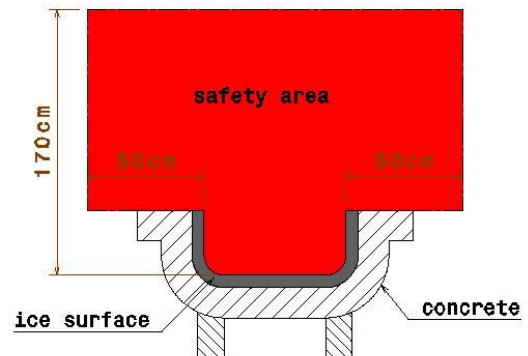
- a) Temporary structures as well as people to use the devices within and near the track's safety zone are inspected and checked by the Technical Delegate (TD) of the FIL.
- b) The Technical Delegate (TD) has the right to prohibit temporary structures and their use as well as the use of devices within and near the track's safety zone or only allow this under conditions.
- c) If changes are made to the structures and installations, the Technical Delegate (TD) is to be informed immediately.

4. Dismantling

- a) All temporary structures and installations are to be dismantled after the conclusion of the FIL event.
- b) Those who erected the temporary structures and installations are responsible for their proper dismantling without damage.

5. Miscellaneous

The institution that ran the structures and installations is responsible and liable for the correct handling of the temporary structures, information, the compliance with conditions, as well as the timely announcement of any changes.
