The FIL Executive Board hereby approves the establishment of an AIN Panel consisting of Dwight Bell (Chairman), Christoph Schweiger, Claire Del Negro, Thomas Schwab, Leon Felderer and Dr. Thomas Summerer (Germany based attorney who represented the FIL at the CAS hearing) as members. The Executive Board authorizes this panel to implement the AIN process in accordance with guidelines set forth by the IOC including but not limited to background checks and anti-doping investigations for all athletes proposed by the Russian Luge Federation and entourage (in the case of background checks). Further, all proposed AIN athletes must abide by all FIL and WADA/ITA regulations and will be subject to all of the same requirements as required by all athletes participating in FIL sanctioned events, including the Olympic Qualification process as approved by the IOC.

Executive Resolution 40/25 (circular resolution)

Pursuant to the AIN guidelines established by the IOC dated 28 March 2023 (see the attachment to this resolution), it is up to each International federation to define which event are deemed as “Team” events, as Team events are not permitted under the IOC AIN guidelines. Therefore, it is proposed that the FIL Executive Board confirms that as referenced in the FIL IRO, Men’s and Women’s Doubles Teams, Team Relay, and Mixed Team events are “Team” events, and therefore not eligible for AIN athletes.

Exekutivbeschluss 44/25 (circular resolution)

On the basis of the “IOC Principles Relating to the Implementation of the Participation for AIN and their Support Personnel with a Russian Passport at the Olympic Winter Games Milano Cortina 2026”, dated 19 September 2025, and after intensive discussions within the independent FIL AIN Panel and between the AIN Panel and the IOC, and based on the conclusion of the independent FIL panel, the FIL Executive Board approves the eligibility of the athletes and support personnel proposed by the Russian Luge Federation to compete as AIN in the single’s competitions except the athlete Semen Pavlichenko and the coach Sergei Chudinov.

In its assessment, the Executive Board follows the independent FIL AIN panel’s and the IOC’s interpretation that the mandatory military service in Russia lasting one year is not sufficient for an exclusion.

On the basis of the IOC Principles Relating to the Implementation of the Participation for AIN and their Support Personnel with a Russian Passport at the Olympic Winter Games Milano Cortina 2026, dated 19 September 2025, and after intensive discussions between the independent FIL AIN Panel and the IOC evaluating new evidence, the FIL Executive Board hereby modifies its recent Resolution deciding to hold eligible all athletes and support personnel proposed by the Russian Luge Federation to compete as AIN in the single’s competitions except the athletes Semen Pavlichenko, Alexandr Gorbatsevich, Sofia Mazur, Ksenia Shamova and the coaches Sergei Chudinov, Artem Petrakov.
