Acknowledgement of the Rules and Regulations of the FIL

☐ I bindingly acknowledge the Statutes and Regulations of the FIL, especially the IRO, the FIL Anti-Doping Code, the Law and Procedure Regulation as well as the respectively valid eligibility regulations of the FIL, including the "Book of Requirements for Athletes" and declare that I have knowledge of the contents of all regulations.

Data Protection Declaration

☐ I acknowledge and agree that my personal data are stored, processed, published for non-commercial purposes, rectified, and deleted by the FIL, its employees and organs as well as by service providers who are contractually obligated to data protection within the scope of the federation's purposes as stated in the FIL statutes.

The legal basis is Article 6 GDPR.

I have been informed that upon request, I will receive information about the data stored about me and that I have the right to demand the correction or deletion or limitation of the processing. I am also aware that I have the right of withdrawal regarding the storage and processing of my data. The data protection officer of the FIL, who is published on the website of the FIL, is responsible for the handling of my concerns in data protection.

For anti-doping related data, the FIL will comply with the Retention Times as provided in the International Standard for Protection of Privacy and Personal Information (ISPPPI) of WADA.

Officials-Agreement on the FIL Anti-Doping Code

☐ I hereby acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. I have received and had the opportunity to review the FIL Anti-Doping Code including all of its enclosures.

2. I consent and agree to comply with and be bound by all of the provisions of the FIL Anti-Doping Code, including but not limited to, all amendments and supplementations and all International Standards incorporated in this Code.

3. I acknowledge and agree that the FIL, the ITA, the National Federations, IOC and WADA may store electronically medical and other personal data as far as this data might be useful for the fight against doping, the determination of whereabouts, the assessment of applications for a TUE as well as the assessment and sanction of doping violations.

4. I acknowledge and agree that FIL has jurisdiction to impose sanctions as provided in the FIL Anti-Doping Code.

5. I acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of a decision made pursuant to the FIL Anti-Doping Code, after exhaustion of the process provided for in the FIL Anti-Doping Rules, may be appealed exclusively as provided in Article 13 to an appellate body for final and binding arbitration, which in the case of International-Level Athletes is the "CAS" and "CAS ADD".

6. I acknowledge and agree that the decisions of the arbitral appellate body referenced above shall be final and enforceable, and that I will not bring any claim, arbitration, lawsuit or litigation in connection with the FIL Anti-Doping Code before any other court or tribunal.

FIL Ethics Code
